# **GETTING STARTED**

Thank you for purchasing a V.360° Video Conference Camera Kit! You can now use your existing conference calling solution (Skype, FaceTime, Hangouts, etc) and be able to see everyone in the room! This guide will walk you through our simple plug and play setup that requires no special software to operate. When connected to your laptop, the V.360°'s cylindrical output delivers a seamless 360° 6480x1080 panoramic strip that can be broadcast real-time over your existing video calling software. Let's get started!

### SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unpack all contents from the V.360° Conference Kit box.
- Insert battery into the V.360° Camera and close using included Port access cover making sure cable ports are visible in opening.
- 3.Screw V.360° onto the top of the Extend-able tripod.
- 4. Follow the wiring diagram (fig1) to attach the V.360° to your computer.
- 5.V.360° can be powered by its battery or by plugging into an outlet via the USB Cable and AC Adapter.
- 6. With the Camera ON and plugged in, open your chosen video conferencing solution and select the V.360° as your default camera.7. Enjoy!

#### NOTES

- V.360° HD Video Camera can be powered on by connecting USB power, connecting via Companion app, or remote control (must be paired first)
- V.360° Companion Android/iOS app provides enhanced capability but is not required for teleconferencing kit
- The V.360 will send a 360° panoramic view to the computer (as shown below in Skype for Windows)
